

# Mix & Match Dies

# TIPS & TRICKS



- 
- ▶ To easily remove your die from the packaging without bending it, fold the packaging in half so you can pop the die off.
  - ▶ Use nail polish remover to remove the excess packaging tape from the back of the die before using.
  - ▶ Use waxed paper between the die and cardstock for easy removal.
  - ▶ When cutting and embossing at the same time, tape the cutting die and embossing plate to keep them together.
  - ▶ For a really defined embossed shape use your cutting die with the embossing mats. It will make the impression without cutting your design.
  - ▶ To create a letterpress effect, ink the embossing plate and then run it through your machine.
  - ▶ For a lasting emboss to fabric or ribbon, spray "Stiffen Stuff" on your desired material and then run it through your machine following the embossing directions.
